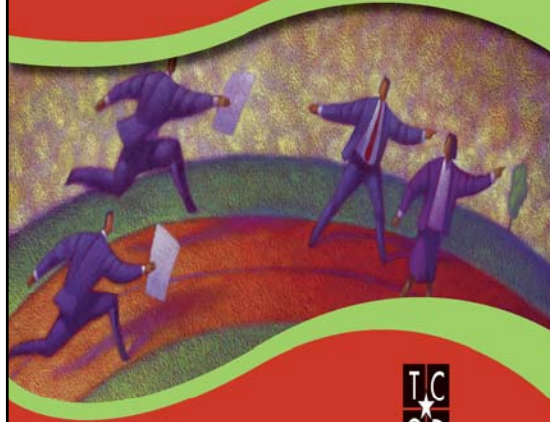

## Some Characteristics of Funders

- Public funders establish new programs while most private funders support a part of a program/ organization
- Public funders have hard deadlines while most private funders have rolling deadlines
- Public funders require more rigorous evaluations than private funders



## Analyzing Your Fit with Funders

- Does the proposed program match the goals, objectives and priorities of the funder?
- Do we have the capacity to administer the funds?
- Can we make the required match, if any?
- Can we bring the required collaborators to the table?
- Is our organization eligible?  
Can we submit a competitive proposal?
